




Key Findings

A solid state-based sample from the 118 Dealer responses

Overall, the consensus is the satisfaction on current turnover level are down, a trend continuing from the previous iteration of the survey.

The higher reported inventory levels for new and used machinery from the previous report is also continuing.

The expectation for increased sales has come away since February 23, only Combine Harvesters have a stronger positive than the previous reporting.


Workforce expansion is now unlikely, the percent of businesses looking to increase has come away further, and we are now seeing a growing who are looking to decrease, while 60% of businesses reported they were not planning on changing.









Overall turnover in the next 6 months will...









New tractor sales in the next 6 months will...








New combine harvester sales in the next 6 months will...









New baler and hay tools sales in the next 6 months will...








SP sprayer sales in the next 6 months will...









Used equipment sales in the next 6 months will...































